



Waterproof Carpet Cushion Stair Application



Cushioned Support

Installation Guide

Carpet and carpet cushion should be installed by installation professionals in accordance with manufacturer and/or Carpet and Rug Institute's (CRI) most current Installation Standards.



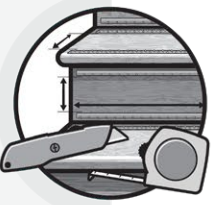
Materials Needed

- HQ Living Waterproof Carpet Cushion (precut to stair dimensions)
- Utility knife
- Carpet Stapler
- Safety gloves and knee pads



Preparation

Before installation, ensure the subfloor is clean, dry, and free of debris. If patching is necessary, use a patching compound specifically formulated for flooring applications. Maintain room temperature between 65°F (18°C) and 95°F (35°C), and keep relative humidity below 65% for at least 24 hours before, during, and after installation.



Installation on Wood Stairs

Step 1 - Cut Cushion:

Cut underlayment to fit the stair tread and riser. Leave a slight gap (~1/4") around edges to prevent bunching.

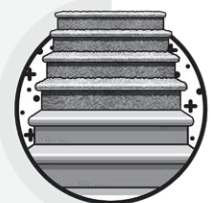
Step 2 - Position on Tread:

Place cushion centered on each tread with air channels facing down. Cushion may be wrapped around the stair nose for added coverage and comfort, if desired.



Step 3 - Fasten to Tread :

- Use 3 to 4 heavy-duty staples along the back edge and 2 to 3 along the sides.
- Do not staple in the center to maintain cushion integrity.



Tips for Success

- Label stair pieces if cutting all in advance.
- Replace any damaged treads or risers before installation.
- If using a wrapped method (nose wrap), ensure cushion conforms securely to nose shape.
